
APPLE Schools Update

Independent Grocer. Aurora is continuing to seek out community support to offset the cost for classroom fruit bins. Thank you again for your generous support of our Thunderbirds!


Learning made fun! To the left, you can see Thunderbirds are making good use of our new interactive SMART TVs that were installed over the summer. The student here
