



Important Dates! Photo retake day is November 15! Parent Teacher Interviews (PTIs) will take place on November 23rd and 24th for Aurora Middle School. We are running blended PTIs this year, with grades 4 through 6 homeroom teachers hosting remote Google Meet (or phone call) interviews at scheduled times like last year, and with grade 7 and 8 teachers hosting in-person PTIs at school with enhanced measures in place. In-person interviews would allow Grade 7-8 parents to seek out the core subject teacher or teachers they need to speak with, rather than the homeroom teacher alone, who may not be able to adequately speak to the concerns in another core subject area. We will have teachers send home information with more details. Thank you for your patience as we try to best serve students and their families while respecting the ongoing challenges of school operations mid-pandemic.
