While it is not mandatory, parents have been encouraged by the province to conduct asymptomatic testing at home, and keep children home when they have any signs of illness or when they have tested positive asymptomatically. While we are no longer contact tracing, we still appreciate parents informing the school about positive cases, so we can continue to assess the overall health of the school and work with AHS and NLPS to respond accordingly.
